## Legal Name Change for CSNO

The Board has adopted a resolution to begin the process of changing the legal name and to submit an official request to the Ministry of Education and Child Care.

Currently, according to Ministerial Order No. 035/2019, the CSNO is officially designated by English names, although its common names are **Conseil scolaire du Nord-Ouest** and **Conseil scolaire catholique du Nord-Ouest**. This initiative aims to ensure that the official French names are recognized and used consistently, both within the government and externally.

This initiative is part of a joint effort among Alberta's Francophone school authorities, which aim to align their legal names with their Francophone educational mission. The province's four Francophone authorities are now engaged in this process, demonstrating a collective and concerted commitment to change.

## CSNO Scholarships 2026

Applications were evaluated for the CSNO's three scholarships:

- Actifs et fiers
- Excellence scolaire
- Voie des métiers

The recipients of the scholarships, each worth \$1,000, will be announced during the graduation ceremonies.

The CSNO also selected its nominee for the FNCSF's Paul-Charbonneau Scholarship.

## Superintendent's Report

Human Resources:



Recruitment for 2026-2027 is underway. Although several positions have been filled, job openings are still posted. We encourage you to view them [HERE](#).

### 2026-2027 programming :

- The new "Class Size Reduction" funding will allow for the addition of one teacher per school (grades K-9) for the 2026-2027 school year. This is in addition to the "Complexity Team" funding announced earlier, which will see the addition of one teacher at École Nouvelle Frontière and one additional educational assistant for École Héritage and École Nouvelle Frontière.
- The Projet Espoir will not be renewed for 2026-2027; funds will be reallocated to inclusion initiatives in schools.

### Pre-planning Projects (Slave Lake and High Level)

- In Slave Lake, the report is encouraging. The community has shown strong enthusiasm for a Francophone school, and the report recommends building an M-12 school, with a program opening in a leased space as early as 2027.
- In High Level, however, despite similar efforts, interest has been limited, and the report recommends re-evaluating the project at a later date.

### Bill 25:

- This bill proposes amendments to the Alberta Education Act to ensure the neutrality and impartiality of classroom instruction. The administration is awaiting further details before implementing the required operational changes.

## Policies

The Board approved the revisions for policies : 1 (Vision, Mission, Values), 13 (Teacher Appeals), 7 (Board Committees), and 8 (Board Representatives).
